STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to chapter 608 of the Private and Special Laws of 1893, entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Atlantic Shore Line Electric Railroad Company, and to authorize the construction of the same across tide waters."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All the provisions of chapter 608 of the 2 Private and Special Laws of 1893 relating to the incorpo-3 ration of the Atlantic Shore Line Electric Railroad Com-4 pany are hereby extended for and during the term of two 5 years from March 28, 1895.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
