STATE OF MAINE.

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to amend Chapter four hundred and eight of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-five entitled An Act to Incorporate the city of Biddeford as amended by Chapter nine of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven in relation to the Election of Constables.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter nine of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on and after its approval by the governor.
