STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to renew and amend the charter of the Van Buren
Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All of the provisions of chapter 324 of the
2 Private and Special Laws of 1891, entitled "An Act to
3 incorporate the Van Buren Water Company" are hereby
4 continued in force, and the said company is given a further
5 period of two years from the date hereof in which to organ-
6 ize, begin building its works, and commence business.

SECT. 2. For the purpose of building and extending its
2 works through Van Buren village, said corporation, when
3 it shall have been duly organized, is hereby authorized from
4 time to time to issue its bonds for such amount as shall be

.5 equal to the amount of stock subscribed for, up to that time,
.6 and not exceeding in all the sum of twenty-five thousand
.7 dollars, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding six per
.8 cent per annum, and secured by mortgage upon the prop-
.9 erty and franchise of said corporation.
