STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE,

AN ACT to make the Orrington Agricultural Society a beneficiary under the laws paying stipends to agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Orrington Agricultural Society of
2 Penobscot county, shall be paid the fair share of the annual
3 stipends provided by law for agricultural societies subject
4 to the conditions imposed by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
