
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to create a lien for towing Logs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Owners of steamboats employed in towing
- 2 logs or lumber on any of the inland waters of this state,
- 3 shall have a lien on such logs or lumber for the amount due
- 4 for such towing. Said lien shall take precedence of all
- 5 other claims except liens reserved to the state, labor liens, 6 and liens for stumpage.
 - SECT. 2. Section forty-two of chapter ninety-one of
- 2 the Revised Statutes, is hereby made applicable to suits
- 3 brought to enforce the above lien.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
