STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Caribou to purchase a lot of land upon which to build a Court House, and convey the same to the county of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The town of Caribou is hereby empowered and author2 ized to purchase a lot of land in said town at any price
3 not exceeding two thousand dollars for the purposes of a
4 court house and to convey the same, when purchased,
5 under the hand and seal of the treasurer of said town in
6 fee simple, to the county of Aroostook for the purpose of
7 erecting a court house thereon and such other buildings
8 as it may thereafter be deemed expedient by the commis-

9 sioners of said county to place thereon for the use and 10 purposes of said county, provided that the inhabitants of 11 said town shall, by a majority vote of those present at a 12 legal meeting called for the purpose, authorize the same.
