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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend an Act to incorporate the Portland Safe  
Deposit Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter seventy of the Private and Special Laws of  
2 1875, is hereby amended by asserting after the word  
3 "kind" in the seventh line of section one of said Act, the  
4 words 'And with the right to act as trustee for corpora-  
5 tions having securities or valuables for deposit in pledge  
6 to secure bonded or other indebtedness,' so that said sec-  
7 tion one of said Act as amended shall read as follows, to  
8 wit :

‘Section 1. Lorenzo D. M. Sweat, Francis K. Swan,  
10 William Hammond, Ardon W. Coombs, their associates  
11 and successors, are hereby made a corporation by the  
12 name of the Portland Safe Deposit Company, for the pur-  
13 pose of receiving on deposit, for safe keeping, government  
14 securities, stocks, bonds, coins, jewelry, plate, valuable  
15 papers and documents, and other property of every kind,  
16 and with the right to act as trustee for corporations hav-  
17 ing securities or valuables for deposit in pledge to secure  
18 bonded or other indebtedness, upon terms to be prescribed  
19 by the corporation, with all the powers and privileges and  
20 subject to the duties, restrictions and liabilities, set forth  
21 in the forty-sixth chapter of the Revised Statutes, and in  
22 all the general laws which now are or hereafter may be in  
23 force relating to such corporations.’
