
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to abate taxes on township number four range five,
west of Kennebec River in Somerset County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

One hundred and nine dollars and seventy cents of the
2 state tax for the year 1893, and ninety-nine dollars and
3 seventy-three cents of the state tax for the year 1894, on
4 township number four, range five, west of Kennebec river
5 in Somerset county, are hereby abated.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

We have examined the Act referred to, and have investigated the matter. The abatement asked for should be made. We are satisfied that through misinformation we valued said township too high in the valuation on which the state taxes for 1893 and 1894 were based. The abatement will reduce them to the basis of our present valuation.
