STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Charles Forster to dam the waters of
the outlet of Jennie Pond, located in the towns of Mexico
and Carthage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Charles Forster, his heirs and assigns are
2 hereby authorized to dam the waters of the outlet of Jennie
3 pond, located in the towns of Mexico and Carthage, to a
4 point not exceeding three feet above extreme high water
5 mark.

SECT. 2. All persons or corporations who shall sus-
2 tain any damages in consequence of the flowage of water in
3 said Jennie pond, shall receive a fair and equitable compen-
4 sation therefor; and if any person sustaining damages as

5 aforesaid, and said Charles Förster, shall not mutually agree
6 upon the sum to be paid therefor, such person may cause
7 his damages to be assessed in the same manner and under
8 the same conditions and limitations as are by law provided
9 in the case of damages by the laying out of public highways.
