
AN ACT to fix the salary of the Register of Probate for the
county of Penobscot.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. From and after January first, eighteen
2 hundred and ninety-five, the register of probate for the
3 county of Penobscot shall receive an annual salary of
4 thirteen hundred dollars, and an additional allowance of
5 eight hundred dollars for clerk hire; said salary and
6 allowance to be paid from the county treasury, and to be
7 instead of the salary and fees now provided by law, and
8 all fees now received by said register as register of pro-

9 bate or register of insolvency shall be paid by said regis-
10 ter into the county treasury for the use of the county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
