STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the Public Laws of 1887, relating to the Fortnightly Payment of Wages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of 2 the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, is 3 hereby amended by adding thereto the words 'by any 4 employed to whom wages is their due,' so that said section 5 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Any corporation violating any of the provi-7 sions of this act, shall be punished by a fine not less than 8 ten nor more than twenty-five dollars on each complaint 9 under which it is convicted, provided, complaint for such

10 violation is made within thirty days from the date thereof,11 by any employee to whom wages is then due.'
