## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to make legal and valid certain doings of the Skowhegan Electric Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The construction of its lines and the loca2 tion of its posts as now owned and operated by the Skow3 hegan Electric Light Company in the towns of Skowhegan
4 and Norridgewock are hereby made legal and valid, as
5 though the same had been done strictly in accordance with
6 chapter 378 of the Public Laws of 1885.

Sect. 2. All claims for damages provided for in said 2 chapter 378 and all other rights of parties interested shall

- 3 be reserved to them the same as though the construction of
- 4 said lines and the location of said poles were made at the
- 5 date when this act shall take effect.
