STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to limit the time for the taking of tolls by the
Kittery Point Bridge Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The right of the proprietors of the Kittery Point bridge
2 over Spruce creek in the town of Kittery, to take tolls as
3 specified in section four of chapter seventy-one of the
4 Private and Special Laws of 1836, shall forever cease
5 after the filing of the award of the committee appointed
6 by the Supreme Judicial Court of York county, to assess
7 the damages for taking said bridge, under chapter 356 of
8 the Private and Special Laws of 1893, and the tender of
9 the amount of said award to the proprietors of said bridge,

10 provided, however, that from and after the filing of said
11 award, and tender thereof, the town of Kittery shall
12 assume the custody and repairs of said bridge, and liabili-
13 ties for defects therein, until the ownership thereof shall
14 become legally vested in said town.
