STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 380 of the Private and Special Laws of 1893 relating to the Charter of the Caribou Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 380 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out 3 the word "and" in the third line between the words "Caribou 4 and Fort Fairfield," and adding after the word Fort Fair-5 field, 'Washburn and Presque Isle,' so that said section 6 shall read as follows:

SECT. 2. The Caribou Water Company is authorized 2 and empowered to carry on the business of furnishing 3 light heat and power by electricity, in the towns of

4 Caribou, Fort Fairfield, Washburn and Presque Isle, with 5 all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the liabili-6 ties of similar corporations, and subject to the general laws 7 of the state regulating, the erection of posts and wires 8 used for purposes of electricity.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
