STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Caribou to fund its Indebtedness at Maturity and to issue New Bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Caribou is hereby authorized 2 to fund its indebtedness at maturity, and for this purpose 3 to issue bonds, in such form and amount, and with such 4 rates of interest, and payable at such times and in such 5 manner as shall be determined by vote of said town, under 6 a proper article in the warrant at a legal town meeting.

SECT. 2. To carry into effect the provisions of this act, 2 said town is hereby authorized to pass such votes, as may 3 be deemed necessary and proper, to enter into and make

4 any contract or agreement not inconsistent with the laws
5 of this State.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
