STATE OF MAINE.

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Union Safe Deposit
and Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section seven of the charter of the Union Safe Deposit
2 and Trust Company is hereby amended by adding thereto
3 the following:

‘Said corporation may become surety upon any bond
5 required to be given by any party in any matter or pro-
6 ceeding in any court sitting in this state, or by any per-
7 son holding any position of trust in which a bond is
8 required.’

So that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Section 7. Said corporation may be appointed execu-
11 tor, trustee or assignee, with the same powers and duties
12 as are conferred and imposed by law upon natural persons
13 acting in the same capacities and subject to the same con-
14 trol of the courts having jurisdiction of the same, in all
15 proceedings relating to the exercise of these powers all
16 papers may be signed and sworn to by any officer desig-
17 nated by the corporation for that purpose, and the officers
18 shall be subject to citation and examination in the same
19 manner and to the same extent as natural persons acting
20 in the same capacities. No sureties shall be required
21 upon the bond of the corporation when acting in said
22 capacities. Said corporation may become surety upon
23 any bond required to be given by any party in any matter
24 or proceeding in any court sitting in this state, or by any
25 person holding any position of trust in which a bond is
26 required.’
