IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend an act entitled "An Act to supply the people of South Gardiner Village in the city of Gardiner with pure water."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The charter granted to Sherburne Lawrence, Hiram 2 Lawrence, Charles Lawrence and Van R. Beedle and their 3 associates and successors, by Chapter 521 of the Private 4 and Special Laws of 1893, to supply the people of South 5 Gardiner village with pure water is hereby extend two 6 years from the 17th day of March 1895.
