STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT additional to, and amendatory of, chapter five hundred and eighty-five of the Private and Special Laws of A. D. 1893, entitled “An Act to incorporate the Kennebec Water Power Company.”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter (585) five hundred and eighty-five of the Private and Special Laws of 3 A. D. 1893, entitled “An Act to incorporate the Kenne-
4 bec Water Power Company,” are hereby extended and
5 made applicable to Spencer pond, situate in No. 3, range
6 5, and No. 4, range 6, in Bingham’s purchase west of

7 Kennebec river, and to Lang pond situate in No. 3, range
8 4, in Bingham's purchase west of Kennebec river, in the
9 county of Somerset, and a further time of four years from
10 the date of the approval of this act is hereby granted to
11 said corporation for the purpose of commencing and pros-
12 ecuting the objects of said act of incorporation.

SECT. 2. All dams or other structures owned or con-
2 trolled by said company shall be so constructed with proper
3 roll ways, sluice ways, gates, or other contrivances, and so
4 managed, as to facilitate and not impede or interfere with
5 the floating or driving of logs in Kennebec river or its trib-
6 utaries.
