STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Androscoggin Preparatory
School of Medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Charles E. Williams, Charles E. Norton, 2 Fred L. Dixon, George P. Emerson, William B. Small, 3 Benjamin G. W. Cushman and John F. Hilton, their associtates and successors, are hereby created a corporation by 5 the name of the Androscoggin Preparatory School of Medicine, to be established in the city of Lewiston, with all the 7 powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties and 8 liabilities by law incident to corporations of a similar 9 nature.

- SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to 2 establish a preparatory school for the purpose of giving 3 medical instruction to students fitting for or members of a 4 medical school or college; and it shall have the power to 5 grant to such students certificates of attainment in studies 6 but not to confer any medical degree.
- SECT. 3. Such corporation may take and hold by pur-2 chase, gift, devise, or bequest, personal or real estate, in 3 all not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, owned at 4 any one time, and may use and dispose thereof only for 5 the purposes for which the corporation is chartered.
- SECT. 4. Any one of the persons named in this act 2 may call the first meeting of said corporation at such time 3 and place in the city of Lewiston as he shall designate by 4 written notice thereof to each corporator seven days prior 5 thereto.
 - SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
