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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section 108 of chapter 11 of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to Public Schools.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Amend by inserting in the last line of said section 108  
2 the words 'or four,' so that said section as amended shall  
3 read as follows:

'Section 108. The course of study shall occupy two  
5 years with suitable vacations, and with the terms of admis-  
6 sion shall be managed by said superintendent, subject to  
7 the approval of the governor and council. The trustees  
8 may arrange for a course of study, occupying three or  
9 four years, for such students as may elect to pursue the  
10 same.'
