


AN ACT to amend section 108 of chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Amend by inserting in the last line of said section 108 2 the words 'or four,' so that said section as amended shall 3 read as follows:

'Section 108. The course of study shall occupy two 5 years with suitable vacations, and with the terms of admis-6 sion shall be managed by said superintendent, subject to 7 the approval of the governor and council. The trustees 8 may arrange for a course of study, occupying three or 9 four years, for such students as may elect to pursue the 10 same.'
