


AN ACT to authorize the building of a Fish Weir in Sand Cove.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. William Herrick, his associates and assigns, 2-are hereby authorized to build and maintain a fish weir in 3 Sand Cove, so-called, on the easterly side of Marshall's 4 Island in the county of Hancock, and to extend the same 5 twelve hundred feet into tide waters.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
