STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Houlton Fish and Game
Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Walter Mansur, E. B. White, George H.
2 Gilman, F. F. Ennis, L. O. Ludwig, George B. Dunn,
3 C. L. Fox, E. S. Estabrooks, C. C. West, George Cary,
4 Eugene K. Peck, R. W. Shaw, Harry M. Briggs, and all
5 persons who may hereafter become associated with them,
6 are hereby created a corporation by the name of the
7 "Houlton Fish and Game Association," for the purpose of
8 protecting fish and game in the county of Aroostook, and
9 propagating fish in the waters of Aroostook county, and

10 by that name shall have power to sue and be sued, and
11 possess all the rights and privileges of corporations under
12 the laws of this State.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may elect such officers as it
2 may deem necessary ; and may take, hold and convey real
3 and personal property to an amount not exceeding one hun-
4 dred thousand dollars in value ; and may adopt such con-
5 stitutions and by-laws, rules and regulations, not incon-
6 sistent with the laws of this state, as they may deem proper,
7 for the management of their affairs, including the admission,
8 government and expulsion of members.

SECT. 3. The first meeting of this corporation may be
2 called by any one of the persons named in this act, by pub-
3 lishing notice of the time and place of such meeting, in the
4 Aroostook Pioneer, for one week prior to such meeting.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
