STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section sixty-nine of chapter six, of the Revised Statutes, relating to Taxes on Lands in places not incorporated.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 69 of chapter 6 of the Revised 2 Statutes, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof

3 the words, 'the state assessors shall make lists thereof

4 with as many divisions as will secure equitable taxation,

5 conforming as near as convenient to known divisions and

6 separate ownership and report the same to each successive

7 legislature'; so that said section as amendedshall read as

8 follows:

'Section 69. Lands not exempt, and not liable to be 10 assessed in any town, may be taxed by the legislature for 11'a just proportion of all state and county taxes as herein 12'provided for ordering the state and county taxes upon 13 property liable to be assessed in towns. The state asses-14 sors shall make lists thereof with as many divisions as will 15 secure equitable taxation, conforming as near as is con-16'venient to known divisions and separate ownership and 17 report the same to each successive legislature.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
