STATE OF MAINE.

AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 46.

Amend the title by adding after the words "State of Maine" the words 'In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.'

AMENDMENT "B."

Amend section one by striking out all after the word "said" in the fifth line and add instead thereof the following: 'said section as amended shall read as follows:'

'Section 1. The towns of Boothbay Harbor and South-
2 port, or either of them, are hereby authorized to erect and
3 maintain a toll bridge across Townsend Gut, so-called, to
4 connect the town of Boothbay Harbor with the island
5 town of Southport, both in the county of Lincoln.'

Said bridge is to be erected across said tide waters, from
7 a point on the bank of said gut, near the residence of Cyrus
8 A. Thompson, in said Southport, and extending across
9 said tide waters, to a point on the opposite bank, near the
10 residence of Joseph McKown in said Boothbay Harbor.
11 Said bridge shall be built of suitable material, in a staunch
12 and strong manner, shall be not less than twenty feet
13 wide, with suitable and proper piers on both sides of the
14 bridge to assist vessels in entering the draw. Said draw
15 shall be properly constructed and secured so that vessels
16 and boats may not be unnecessarily detained, and said
17 vessels and boats to pass and re-pass, free of toll.'
