STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to organize the Plantation of Mayfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Township number two in the second range 2 east of Kennebec river in Bingham's Kennebec purchase, 3 in the county of Somerset, is hereby organized into a plan-4 tation by the name of Mayfield, and is hereby invested with 5 all the powers and privileges and subjected to all the duties 6 and obligations incident to other organized plantations.

SECT. 2. Said plantation is hereby made the legal suc-2 cessor of the former town and plantation of Mayfield, and 3 is invested with all the corporate property of said former 4 town and plantation, and authorized to assume and pay the 5 debts thereof, and to raise money by tax for that purpose.

SECT. 3. The organization of the existing plantation of 2 Mayfield is hereby confirmed and made valid, and the first 3 annual meeting called by the assessors thereof after the 4 passage of this act shall be the first meeting of the planta-5 tion hereby organized.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
