IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to organize the Plantation of Carrying Place.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Township number one in the third range
2 west of Kennebec river in Bingham's Kennebec purchase
3 in the county of Somerset, is hereby organized into a plan-
4 tation by the name of Carrying Place, and is hereby
5 invested with all the powers and privileges and subjected
6 to all the duties and obligations incident to other organized
7 plantations.

SECT. 2. Said plantation is hereby made the legal suc-
2 cessor of the former plantation of Carrying Place and is
3 invested with all the corporate property of said former

4 plantation and authorized to assume and pay the debts
5 thereof and to raise money by tax for that purpose.

SECT. 3. The organization of the existing plantation of
2 Carrying Place is hereby confirmed and made valid and the
3 first annual meeting called by the assessors thereof after
4 the passage of this act shall be the first meeting of the
5 plantation hereby organized.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
