STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT establishing the salary of the County Attorney,
for the County of Androscoggin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The county attorney for the county of
2 Androscoggin shall receive an annual salary from the
3 treasurer of state, of eight hundred dollars payable
4 quarterly on the first days of January, April, July and
5 October, in each year, beginning on the first day of April
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-five, instead of the salary now
7 provided by law.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.
