AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend Section twenty-six of Chapter seventy-three of the Revised Statutes relating to Unrecorded Deeds.

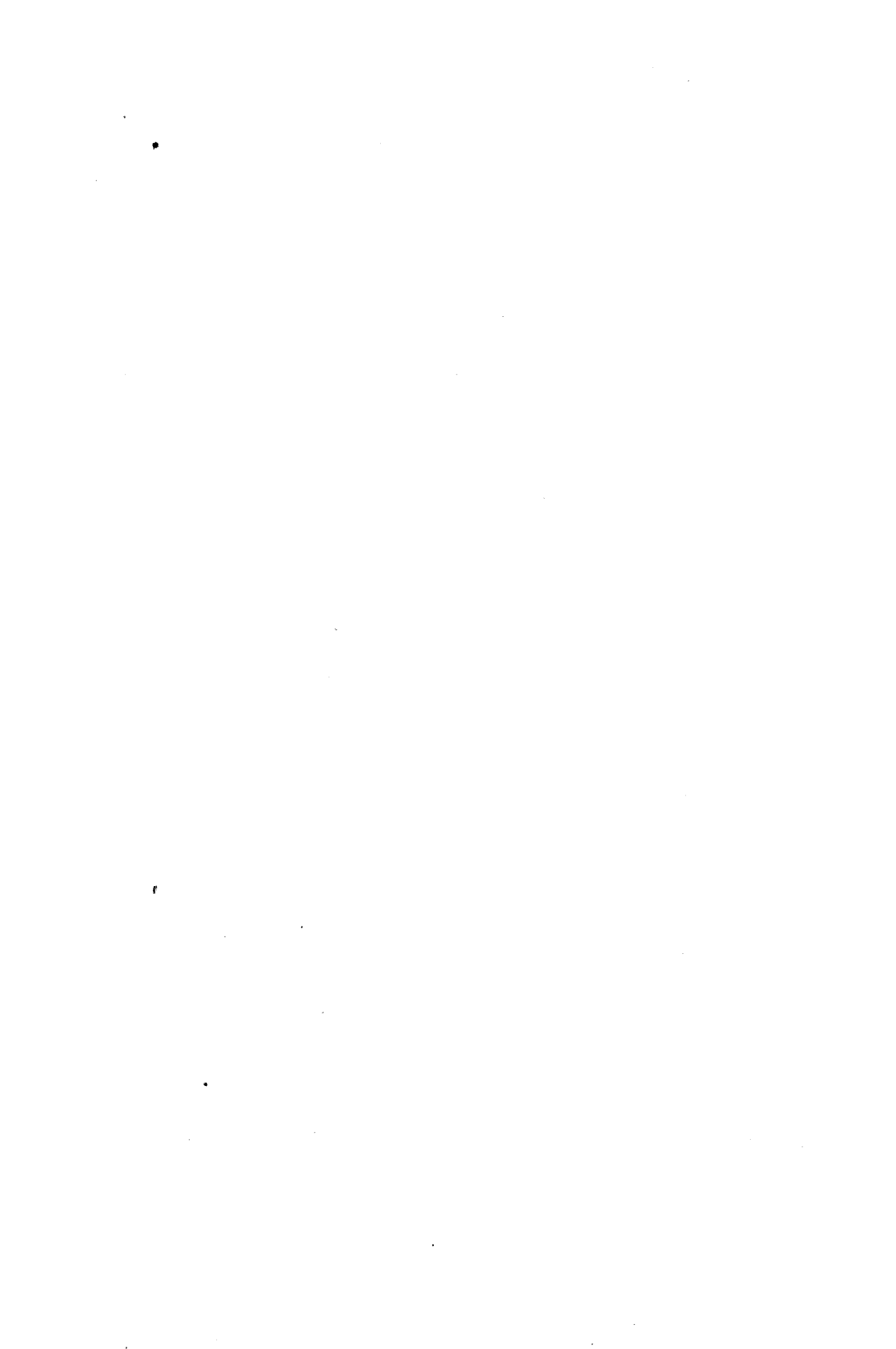
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section twenty-six of chapter seventy-three of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after 3 "County" in the fourth line 'or registry district' so that 4 said section when amended shall read as follows, viz:

'Section 26. If a deed conveying lands in more than 6 one county is lost before being recorded in all, or if a 7 deed is recorded in the wrong county or registry district 8 and lost, a certified copy from a registry where it has

9 been recorded, may be recorded in any other county, or  
10 registry district, with the same effect as a record of the  
11 original.'
