STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT to Incorporate the Portland Veteran Firemen's Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Henry Fox, James W. Plaisted, Ezra 2 Russell, Charles F. Plummer, Richard H. Ball, Andrew 3 J. Cummings, Henry Q Norton, L. B. Bragg, Charles 4 D. Skillin, Amory H. Rogers, Benj. L. Sawyer, Charles 5 Q. Goodhue, John H. Hall, Chas. H. Rich and Chas. H. 6 Leighton, their associates and successors now composing 7 a voluntary association existing in the city of Portland 8 are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the 9 name of the Portland Veteran Firemen's Association and 10 as such may have and enjoy all the powers and privileges,

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11 and shall be subject to all the duties and liabilities per-12 taining to corporations under the general laws of this13 state.

SECT. 2. The object of this association is to promote 2 harmony, establish order, secure success, and continue that 3 friendly feeling with each other which has existed for many 4 years past.

SECT. 3. The constitution or rules by which the affairs 2 and proceedings of the said association are now governed 3 and directed so far as the same are not repugnant to the 4 constitution and laws of this state, shall be and continue to 5 be the by-laws of the corporation hereby constituted, until 6 the same or any of them shall be changed by the act of said 7 corporation.

SECT. 4. This act may be accepted at any regular meet-2 ing of said Portland Veteran Firemen's Association by a 3 majority of the members present; and shall take effect 4 from and after its approval by the governor.
