STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Taxation of Vessel Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All sailing vessels registered or enrolled 2 under the laws of the United States or foreign govern-3 ments; owned wholly or in part by inhabitants of this 4 state, shall be taxed upon an appraised value of twenty 5 dollars per ton gross tonnage for new vessels completed 6 on or before the first day of April of each year. Vessels 7 of one year old or more shall be reduced in value at the 8 rate of one dollar per ton per year for each additional year 9 of age, until they shall have reached the age of seventeen 10 years, at and after which time, said vessels shall be taxed

- 11 upon an appraised value of three dollars per ton, gross 12 tonnage.
- SECT. 2. Vessels when rebuilt shall be taxed on the 2 same valuation as vessels of one-half the age of such rebuilt 3 vessels.
- SECT. 3. A vessel shall be regarded as rebuilt only on 2 an expenditure being made of not less than forty per cent 3 of the cost of such vessel if built entirely new.
- SECT. 4. Vessels if repaired to the extent of twenty2 five per cent of the cost of such vessel if built entirely
 3 new shall be taxed on the same valuation as vessels of five4 eighths of the age of such repaired vessel.
- SECT. 5. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
