**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to establish a Salary for the Clerk of Courts for
Waldo County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

From and after the first day of January eighteen hun-
2 dred and ninety-five, the salary of the clerk of courts for
3 Waldo county, shall be eleven hundred dollars per annum,
4 payable quarterly from the county treasury on the first
5 days of January, April, July and October of each year,
6 for the quarters preceding, to be in full for all services
7 as clerk of the supreme judicial court, and of the county
8 commissioners court; and he shall render an account
9 under oath, to the county treasurer on the first days of
10 January, April, July and October of each year of all fees

11 received by him, or which he is entitled to receive by
12 virtue of his office, and all such fees and accounts shall be
13 for the use and benefit of the county.

It shall be the duty of the county commissioners of said
15 county to examine the accounts of the clerk of courts at
16 the close of each quarter and adopt such rules and regula-
17 tions as they deem expedient for the collection of all fees
18 accruing to the county under this chapter.

All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with this act are
20 hereby repealed.

This act shall take effect when approved.
