STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to the Public Laws of the State of Maine relating to the Illegal Killing of Fish and Game.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That any person acting as guide for any person or party 2 who shall assist or aid such person or party in killing any 3 game or fish in violation of law, shall be held equally 4 responsible for such violation of the law, and subject to 5 the same penalties.
