STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-one of chapter two of the
Revised Statutes, relating to deposits in banks by the State
Treasurer.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section fifty-one of chapter two of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out all after
3 the word "bank" in the second line thereof, and substitut-
4 ing therefor the following words, 'except such bank through
5 which the treasurer desires to meet the payments of the
6 bonded debt and interest on same,' so that said section as
7 amended, shall read:

'Section 51. No more than twenty thousand dollars of
9 the money of the state shall be on deposit in a bank,

10 except such bank through which the treasurer desires to
11 meet the payments of the bonded debt and interest on
12 same.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
