IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to dredge and clean the Sebasticook River in Pittsfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Robert Dobson, William Dobson and Gordon Dobson, 2 each of Pittsfield in Somerset county, a co-partnership 3 underthe name and style of Robert Dobson & Company, 4 their successors and assigns, are hereby empowered and 5 authorized to dredge, blast and clean out the Sebasticook 6 river in the town of Pittsfield, between the easterly end of 7 the Pioneer Woolen Mill and the railroad bridge of Maine 8 Central Railroad Company in order to increase the effigeiency of their water power and any damage that in so

10 doing any abutting land owner or owners may suffer or 11 incur, shall be assessed and determined as is provided for 12 in the usual way of laying out highways.
