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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to authorize the sale of the Union Meeting House  
in Winslow.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The trustees of the Union society or parish  
2 in Winslow in the county of Kennebec are hereby author-  
3 ized and empowered to sell and convey at public auction  
4 or private sale the Union meeting house, so called, in said  
5 Winslow, together with the land, furniture and fixtures  
6 belonging thereto.

SECT. 2. If said trustees decide to sell said meeting  
2 house at public auction they shall cause written notice of  
3 the time and place of such sale to be posted in three public  
4 and conspicuous places in the town of Winslow at least

5 fourteen days before said sale, and shall also cause said no-  
6 tice to be published three weeks successively before said  
7 sale in the Waterville Mail published in the city of Water-  
8 ville.

SECT. 3. The said trustees shall first pay from the pro-  
2 ceeds of said sale all incidental expenses, and such debts as  
3 they shall be satisfied are equitably due from the proprie-  
4 tors or pew owners of said meeting house, and the balance  
5 of the proceeds of said sale shall be divided proportion-  
6 ately to their interest in said property among such of the  
7 proprietors and pew owners thereof as shall within one  
8 year of said sale claim their proportional dividend.

SECT. 4. Said trustees shall within thirty days after  
2 said sale, by publication three weeks successively in the  
3 Waterville Mail, and by posting a like notice in three  
4 public and conspicuous places in the town of Winslow,  
5 give notice that said sale has been perfected and that all  
6 persons claiming any interest in the proceeds thereof may  
7 forthwith give notice of their claim to said trustees. Said  
8 trustees shall keep a list of said claimants and at the end  
9 of said year divide said balance pro rata among said  
10 claimants; and all claims not so presented within said one  
11 year shall be forever barred.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
