STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the Codifying of the laws relating to Sea and Shore Fisheries.

WHEREAS, In consequence of much legislation the laws 2 relating to the sea and shore fisheries are in such condi-3 tion that it is difficult to judge correctly of the intent and 4 meaning and are a source of great annoyance to the fish-5 ermen and the legal fraternity as well, and believing that 6 the best interests of the state would be subserved by the 7 appointment of a commission to carefully consider these 8 laws, therefore be it

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby 10 authorized to appoint as soon as practicable two persons 11 residing in the sea-board counties who, with the commis-

12 sioner of sea and shore fisheries, shall constitute a com-13 mission to investigate, revise, and simplify all the laws 14 relating to the sea and shore fisheries and report to the 15 next legislature.

The compensation of the commission shall be fixed by 17 the governor and council.
