STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT entitled “An Act to authorize the Peoples’ Savings
Bank of Lewiston, Maine, to construct and maintain Safety
Deposit Boxes.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The Peoples’ Savings Bank of Lewiston, Maine, is hereby
2 authorized and empowered to construct, own, maintain,
3 operate and rent for hire safety deposit boxes for the safe
4 keeping of personal property ; provided, however, that
5 said savings bank shall not be liable for any loss of prop-
6 erty deposited in said boxes for safe keeping beyond the

7 sum paid for the hire of the box containing said property
8 so lost ; and provided further, that the construction of said
9 deposit boxes, and their location within the vaults of said
10 bank shall be subject to the approval of the state bank
11 examiner, who shall make careful examination, and certify
12 his approval to said bank before said boxes shall be rented.
