STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter two hundred and seventeen of the Public Laws of 1893 relating to Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter 217 of the Public Laws of 2 1893 is hereby amended by striking out the word "or" in 3 the third line of said section and after the word "rulings" 4 the third line by inserting the words 'and findings' so that 5 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 11. No justice of the supreme judicial court 7 shall sit in the law court upon the hearing of any cause 8 tried before him in which any of his rulings and findings 9 are the subject of review, nor take any part in the deci-10 sion thereof.'
