STATE OF MAINE.

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter three hundred and ninety-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to the charter of the Deer Isle Telephone Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter 396 of the Private 2 and Special Laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking 3 out the word "two" in the second line of said section, and 4 inserting in its place the word 'four,' so that when amended 5 said section shall read as follows :

'Section 8. This charter shall be null and void unless 7 operations shall actually commence hereunder within four 8 years from date of the passage of this act.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
