
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the town of Lisbon to purchase and succeed to the rights of the Lisbon Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The town of Lisbon is hereby authorized and empowered 2 to purchase the charter of the Lisbon Water Company, and 3 thus acquire, hold, and exercise all the rights and prividleges under said charter.
