STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to enlarge powers of Reliable Manufacturing Com-
pany.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Reliable Manufacturing Company for-
2 merly the Car-Track Friction Appliance Company, may
3 enlarge the purposes for which it was organized, as set
4 forth in its certificate of organization, by adding the fol-
5 lowing:

‘As also to acquire, manufacture, sell, lease and license
7 any other mechanical device or article whatsoever.’

SECT. 2. All transactions of said corporation, other-
2 wise legal, within the scope of the powers enumerated in

3 the preceding section of this act, since June 17, 1890, are
4 hereby confirmed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
