STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to state taxes on wild lands where the soil and the growth thereon are owned by different persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. When the soil of townships or tracts taxed 2 by the state as wild land, is not owned by the person or 3 persons who own the growth or part of the growth thereon, 4 the state assessor shall value the soil and such growth 5 separately for purposes of taxation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
