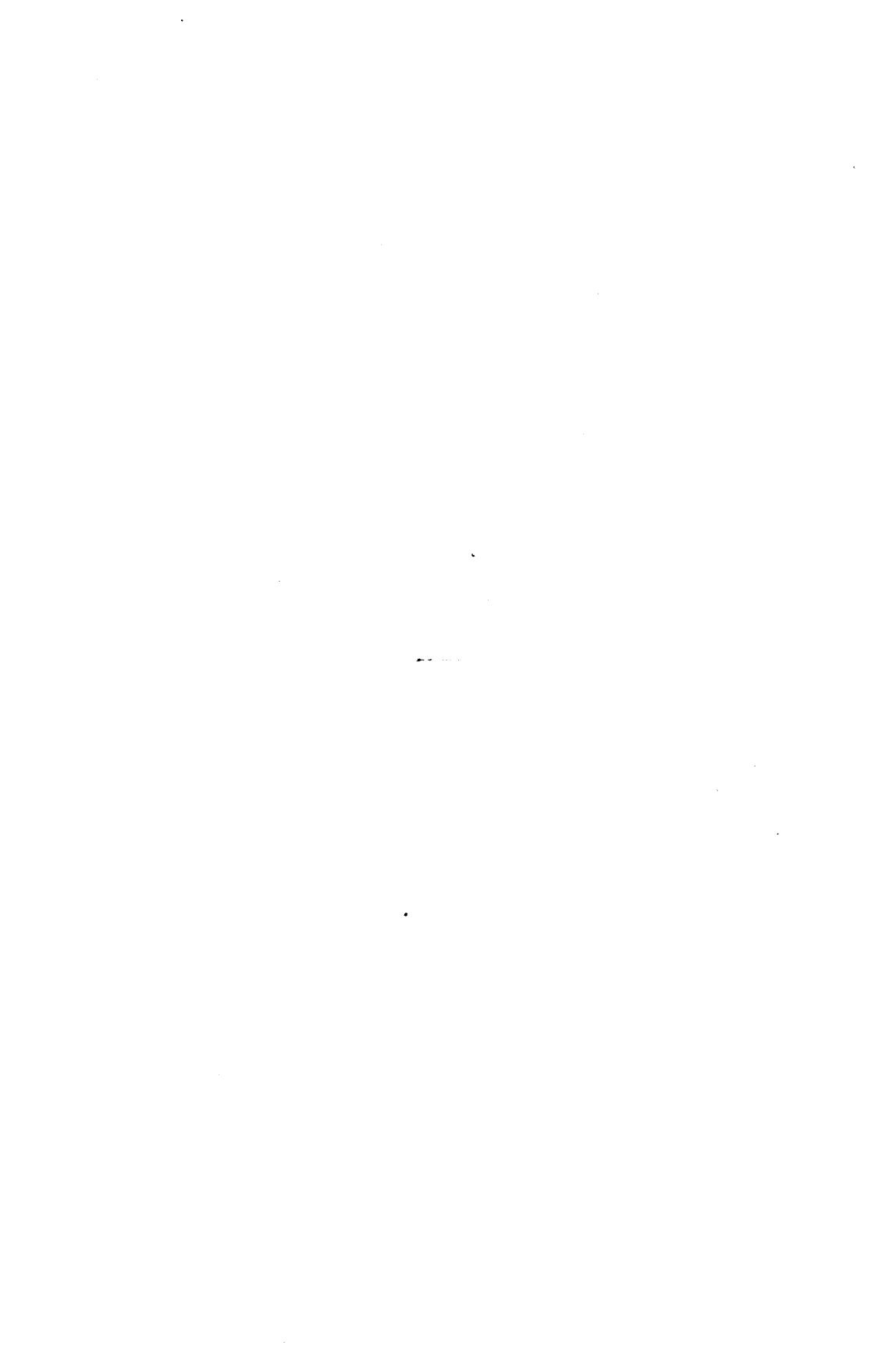
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in Little Rattlesnake
pond in the town of Raymond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take any fish
2 from Little Rattlesnake pond or its tributaries, in the town
3 of Raymond, in the county of Cumberland, for a term of
4 two years from the date of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act
2 shall be punished by a fine of ten dollars for each offence,
3 and one dollar additional for each fish taken, to be recov-
4 ered by complaint, before any trial justice or municipal
5 court in said county, one-half to the use of the prosecutor
6 and one-half to the county.
