STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section ninety of chapter six of the
Revised Statutes, relating to the assessment of county
taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section ninety of chapter six of the Revised Statutes is
2 hereby amended by adding after the word "valuation" in
3 the third line the following: 'they may add such sum above
4 the sum so authorized, not exceeding two per cent of
5 said sum as a fractional division renders convenient, and
6 certify that fact in the record of said apportionment,' so
7 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 90. When a county tax is authorized, the
9 county commissioners shall in March in the year for which

10 such tax is granted apportion it upon the towns and other
11 places according to the last state valuation, they may add
12 such sum above the sum so authorized, not exceeding two
13 per cent of said sum, as a fractional division renders con-
14 venient, and certify that fact in the record of said appor-
15 tionment, and issue their warrant to the assessors requir-
16 ing them forthwith to assess the sum apportioned to their
17 town or place and to commit their assessment to the con-
18 stable or collector for collection.'
