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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the County of Androscoggin.

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*Resolved*, That the sum of one hundred and seventy  
2 dollars be, and hereby is appropriated out of any moneys  
3 in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be paid  
4 to the treasurer of the county of Androscoggin, for the use  
5 of said county, the same being a reimbursement to said  
6 county for moneys paid the county commissioners of said  
7 county for services in apportioning the taxes between the  
8 towns of Poland, Mechanic Fall and Minot.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The County Commissioners of Androscoggin county, by an act of the Legislature of 1893, section one, chapter 614 were created a commission, and authorized to decide and determine what sums of money should be paid by the town of Mechanic Falls, as its share of the state and county taxes, which had been assessed on the towns of Poland and Minot for the years 1893 and 1894. That no provisions was made in said act for the re-imbusement of the county of Androscoggin for the service and expenses of said commissioners. That said commissioners attended to the dates required, and their services and expenses amounting to \$170, which has been paid out of the treasury of Androscoggin county as follows :
