
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to set off a part of Ward Five and annex the same to Ward Four in the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All that part of ward five, in the city of 2 Lewiston, which is bounded as follows, viz: On the north 3 by Ash street; on the east by Horton street; on the south 4 by Walnut street, and on the west by Bates street, is 5 hereby set off from said ward five and annexed to and made 6 a part of ward four, in said city.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
