STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Bar Harbor Water
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. In addition to the powers conferred upon
2 it by its act of incorporation and by acts amendatory
3 thereof, and additional thereto, the Bar Harbor Water
4 Company for the purposes of its incorporation shall have
5 the following powers:

SECT. 2. To purchase and hold the stock of the Eden
2 Water Company, a corporation organized under the laws
3 of the State of Maine, being same corporation named in
4 special act of 1893, chapter 548.

SECT. 3. To take, detain and use, but not exclusively,
2 the water of Turtle Lake and of the stream flowing thence
3 to Eagle Lake, and of any stream tributary to either of
4 said lakes.

SECT. 4. To erect a dam or dams for the purpose of
2 raising the level and increasing the capacity of either or
3 both of said lakes, or of any such stream. Damages caused
4 by flowage shall be assessed and paid in the manner pro-
5 vided by the Bar Harbor Water Company's charter in case
6 of taking land for any of its corporate purposes.

SECT. 5. To supply water to the inhabitants of any
2 part of the town of Eden not only for domestic purposes,
3 but also for shipping and the extinguishment of fires.
