STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the land agent to sell certain interests in the reserved lots in the Plantation of Mayfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The land agent is hereby authorized to sell 2 and convey for such price as to him may seem just, all 3 the interest which has not been sold by the town of May-4 field in the reserved or school lots in township number 5 two, range two, of Bingham's Kennebec Purchase, east 6 of Kennebec river, which were formerly owned as public 7 lots by the town of Mayfield, said town having now be-8 come a plantation, and to deposit the sum received for 9 such interest in the state treasury for the benefit of the 10 school fund of the plantation of Mayfield.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
