## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State Reform School.

---

*Resolved*, That the sum of fifty thousand five hundred  
2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of  
3 the State Reform School for the years eighteen hundred  
4 and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six for  
5 the following purposes :

For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, for cur-  
7 rent expenses, including mechanical school and Farrington  
8 cottage, nineteen thousand dollars. Finishing wall and  
9 fence, four hundred dollars. To complete painting build-  
10 ings, six hundred dollars. To purchase laundry machinery  
11 dry room, fifteen hundred dollars. Ordinary repairs, one  
12 thousand dollars.

For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six: for cur-  
14 rent expenses including mechanical school and Farrington  
15 cottage, nineteen thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs,  
16 one thousand dollars, and for the construction of a new  
17 cottage, eight thousand dollars.
